Learn watercolour on Signal Hill Established artist offers workshop series

Newfoundland watercolour artist Margaret Walsh Best is offering workshops in painting with watercolours throughout July.

Walsh Best is known for her images of wildflowers, berries and landscapes.

She is a former board member of the Newfoundland and Labrador Arts Council, VANL-CARFAC (Visual Artists Newfoundland & Labrador) and the Art Association of Newfoundland & Labrador.

She has participated in more than 60 group exhibitions.

Over the last decade, she has held solo exhibitions at the MUN

Botanical Gardens, the archaeological interpretation centre in Ferryland and at the Five Island Gallery in Tors Cove. According to her website, she will have an exhibition in County Waterford, Ireland, in 2010.

Her upcoming workshops will be held at Geo Park and the Battery Hotel on Signal Hill.

"Learn some new watercolour techniques or take the time for a refresher as you enjoy St. John's in July," states a promotion for the classes.

The workshops will include: "Simplifying Watercolour" (July 12),

"550 Million Year Old Rocks" (July 13 and July 14) and "Botanical Wonders of Signal Hill" (July 15 and July 16).
